



IGCA Scholarship Criteria

Scholarship must be postmarked April 15

The Iowa Girls' Coaches Association offers a \$500 scholarship to a **female** senior who has been active in high school sports. (Four scholarships will be awarded.)

To apply:

1. Fill out the attached scholarship form. The form must be typed. No handwritten or incomplete applications will be considered.
2. Attach a letter of recommendation from your high school counselor, principal or activities director.
3. Write a one page essay on "The Value of Involvement in High School Activities."

Judging:

1. All applications will be judged on a weighted point system.
2. Special consideration will be given to daughters of active ICGA members and those going into education or coaching.
3. The essay, high school activities and GPA/ACT are the main sources of consideration.
4. Bonus points will be given if the applicant goes into education and/or coaching and if the applicant has a parent that is currently coaching.

Payment:

If the student is chosen for this scholarship, a check for \$500 will be written directly to the student.
